Answers for Agur's questions... (Proverbs 30:19)
an eagle in the sky – a spirit-filled Christian
a man with a maid - Christ and the church
a serpent on a rock – the interplay between Christ & the devil – good and evil
a ship on the seas – the church throughout history

The Bible often uses animals as examples of the nature of good or evil.

- List examples of animals representing *evil*

Snakes, wasps, locusts, wolves

- List examples of animals representing *good*

Lamb, lion, dove

Isaiah 40:28-31

The Eagle in the air can represent our spiritual life

Where Eagles Live:

the highest point, near the edge if on land

The Promise of strength and power ...

V31 –“wait” means to place your HOPE in

V31 “mount up” in Hebrew literally says

sprout wings!

Malachi 4:2 in Hebrew: **kanaph**

an edge or extremity; specifically a wing,

The Lord's strength gives us spiritual lift !

An Eagle is designed to be an overcomer...

The Eagle gives us an excellent picture of being in the world but not of the world.

John 15:19, John 17:13-17

You cannot WIN WITHOUT wings !

Acts 16:25-26 The two wings are

prayer and praise

The TWO kinds of battles

against the elements, against the enemy

Ephesians 6:12 – not *people* but forces in ‘the air’

Storms serve to ‘get us out of the nest’ !

The TWO ways an eagle battles a storm –

Rise above it or face it directly

always ALOFT – *never* on the ground - **Gal. 5:16 (17-22)**

Nehemiah 8:10 – without joy, you are grounded !

The enemy will always attack our God-given territory

Characteristics of a fighting eagle

- **Extraordinary** eyesight

Luke 10:23-24, Rev. 1:11

- **Excellent** memory

Romans 12:1

- territorial nature

Genesis 1:28, Ephesians 6:10

- will not quit, persistent in battle

Romans 8:37, 2 Corinthians 2:14

IMPART
